

## An Announcement from the Pastor about the Saturday 5:30 PM Mass

December 3, 2023

#### **Dear Friends in Christ:**

Our bishop, the Most Reverend Robert Brennan, wrote a letter to the clergy, staffs and parishioners of the parishes of our diocese on November 3,2023. This letter was inserted into our parish bulletin on the weekend of November 4<sup>th</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> and published in the bulletin on the weekend of November 11<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>. In his letter, the bishop explains that in 2017, Mass attendance in our Diocese was reported at an average of 205,502 per weekend. In 2022, the average was reported 124,031. This is a decrease of nearly 40 percent in Mass attendance in our diocese in the last 5 years. Thus, many parishes throughout the diocese with large capacity churches are witnessing a significantly reduced Mass attendance. Also, due to a high number of priest retirements and deaths in recent years, there are fewer priests serving in our 175 parishes.

In light of these realities, the bishop is asking pastors to review and evaluate their Mass schedules, and where prudent, reduce the number of weekend Masses by a least one or maybe more Masses, depending on the number of people attending and the capacity of the church.

Since my arrival at Saint John the Evangelist – Saint Rocco four years ago, of growing concern to me has been our 5:30 PM Saturday Vigil Mass. The attendance at this Mass has dwindled to 5 to 8 people per weekend. One evening during the summer <u>no one</u> attended the Mass. I celebrated the Mass this past weekend and the total attendance was 2 persons. The collection for this Mass rarely exceeds \$50.00. The expense of opening, lighting and heating the church far exceeds the collection. In addition, when I am unavailable to celebrate the Mass, there is the added expense of bringing in a priest.

In light of all these factors, good stewardship of parish's resources has necessitated that I make the difficult decision to discontinue the Saturday, 5:30 PM Vigil Mass effective January 1, 2024. I pray that this decision does not cause anyone undue hardship. I also pray that those parishioners who attend the 5:30 PM will consider joining us for the 8:45 AM Mass on Sundays.

I thank you in advance for your understanding, and please be assured of my desire to continue to effectively serve the pastoral needs of our parish.
