## MISSION APPEAL: JULY 12th

COAR, which stands for the Comunidad Óscar A. Romero, will be making an upcoming mission appeal at St. John the Evangelist-St Rocco on Sunday July 12th and asking for your donations, prayers, and interest. COAR is located in Zaragoza, El Salvador. It was founded in 1980 by a Cleveland Diocese Mission Team priest Fr. Ken Myers during El Salvador's brutal civil war. Fr. Ken and fellow Cleveland Mission Team members Sr. Dorothy Kazel, OSU, and Jean Donovan (murdered December 2, 1980) began gathering orphans from refugee camps and bringing them back to the Mission's parish of Zaragoza. COAR is now known as the "Children's Village" in El Salvador with more than 1,000 day students at the school, as well as residential foster care, a scholarship program, and spiritual support. It is administered directly by the Archbishop of San Salvador through his Vicariate of Human Development. COAR's motto is Women and Men for God and Culture: the curriculum educates the entire person. The community is led by locally-based Salvadoran directors and staff. One of the first orphans of COAR served as mayor of Zaragoza from 1998 - 2002. COAR buzzes with optimism and vitality. However, El Salvador is deeply challenged economically and many of our students and residents have faced extreme poverty. To protect the most vulnerable simply requires food, shelter, education, and support. To educate the children and thus help propel their economy requires updated computers and new classrooms. To get the best teachers and treat them fairly requires wages near the Salvadoran national average. Please help us respond to the needs of the most impoverished among us and help them build a better future.

## LLAMAMIENTO MISIONERO: 12 DE JULIO

COAR (Comunidad Óscar A. Romero) realizará un llamamiento misionero en la parroquia St. John the Evangelist-St. Rocco el domingo 12 de julio, solicitando sus donaciones, oraciones e interés. COAR tiene su sede en Zaragoza, El Salvador. Fue fundada en 1980 por el padre Ken Myers —miembro del Equipo Misionero de la Diócesis de Cleveland— durante la brutal guerra civil de El Salvador. El padre Ken y sus compañeros del equipo misionero de Cleveland, la hermana Dorothy Kazel (OSU) y Jean Donovan (asesinadas el 2 de diciembre de 1980), comenzaron a recoger a niños huérfanos de los campos de refugiados para llevarlos a la parroquia de la misión en Zaragoza. Actualmente, COAR es conocida como la "Aldea de los Niños" en El Salvador; cuenta con más de 1.000 alumnos externos en su escuela, además de ofrecer servicios de acogida residencial, un programa de becas y apoyo espiritual. La organización es administrada directamente por el Arzobispo de San Salvador a través de su Vicaría de Desarrollo Humano. El lema de COAR es "Mujeres y hombres para Dios y la cultura", reflejando un plan de estudios que educa a la persona de manera integral. La comunidad está dirigida por personal y directores salvadoreños de la zona. Uno de los primeros niños acogidos por COAR llegó a ser alcalde de Zaragoza entre 1998 y 2002. COAR rebosa optimismo y vitalidad. Sin embargo, El Salvador enfrenta graves desafíos económicos, y muchos de nuestros estudiantes y residentes han vivido situaciones de pobreza extrema. Proteger a los más vulnerables requiere, sencillamente, proporcionarles alimentos, refugio, educación y apoyo. Educar a los niños y contribuir así al impulso de su economía exige contar con computadoras actualizadas y nuevas aulas. Para atraer a los mejores maestros y ofrecerles un trato justo, es necesario pagar salarios cercanos al promedio nacional salvadoreño. Por favor, ayúdenos a responder a las necesidades de los más pobres entre nosotros y a construir un futuro mejor para ellos.
